



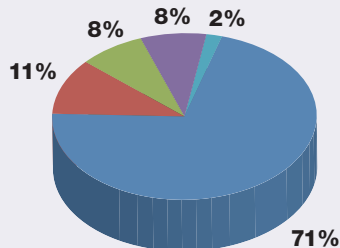

2009 HIGHLIGHTS

- Began "Senior Smiles", an opportunity to reach older adults with current information on chronic gum inflammation, oral cancer, and tooth decay. The main venues for this outreach are the local nutrition sites in five counties: Lucas, Ottawa, Paulding, Sandusky, and Wood. This new opportunity has reached 284 older adults and 95 professionals.
- Hosted the Fourth Annual Toledo Smiles Dental Fair, a community initiative with support from the Junior League of Toledo, and educated 585 students from Jones Middle School.
- As of year-end 2009, Oral Health Knowledge College, a program to train and educate children 5-17 years of age in the skills, techniques and importance of home oral health habits, has educated over 13,000 children in Northwest Ohio.
- A Child Abuse and Neglect policy was approved by the Board of Directors and instituted at the Dental Center. Two trainings were provided at each clinic, laying the foundation for protecting the children of our communities.
- A successful Second Annual "A Toast To Teeth" honoring the Junior League of Toledo, was held at the Nairobi Pavilion at the Toledo Zoo. They were honored for their donation of \$50,000 for the computer, video, digital x-ray and intra-oral camera systems on the Smile Express.
- Assisted 115 families and distributed 350 backpacks to children in the community at the Fourth Annual Back-2-School Parade and Fair Day.
- Received a grant from Health Path Foundation for \$100,000 to purchase a fiber optic hand piece system and a digital x-ray system for the Blanchard Valley Clinic.

2009 INCOME BY CATEGORY

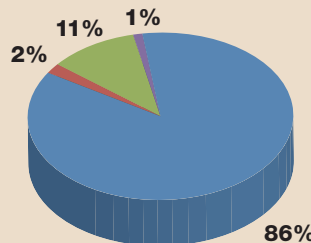
