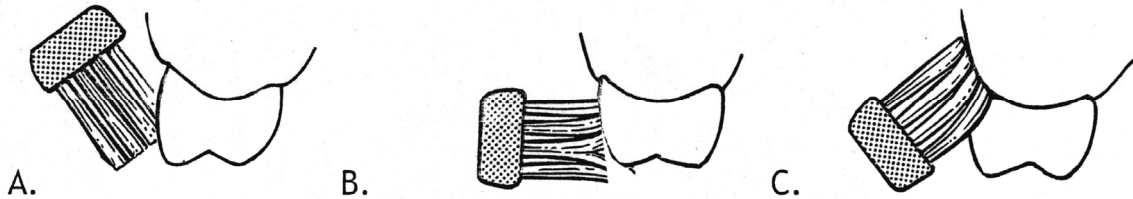
1. In your opinion, how important is dental care for young children's teeth?
